

2024/2025 Expedition Foundation Financial Literacy Grants

The Expedition Foundation is pleased to offer up to \$2,000 in total grants to teachers, departments or schools who are promoting financial literacy to their students. Submitted grants should support instruction of content related to budgeting, credit, money management, economics, saving and investing, or other personal finance topic. Grant funds will be awarded via a check of up to \$500.

- All grades (K-12) and subjects at an accredited Minnesota school are eligible. Grant money can be used to support either a new or existing plan that has not previously received a grant from Expedition Credit Union or Expedition Foundation.
- Deadline for application: Postmarked by December 15, 2024. Completed applications may be mailed to Expedition Foundation, Attn: Grant Selection Committee, 1270
 Northland Drive, Suite 350, Mendota Heights, MN 55120. Incomplete applications and those postmarked later than December 15, 2024, will not be considered. Applications may also be delivered in person to any Expedition Credit Union office or emailed to scholarships@expeditioncu.com on or before the deadline.
- Application materials should be typed or computer word-processed before being submitted.
- Grants will be awarded in early 2025 and winners will be notified by January 31, 2025.
- Grant must be used in the 2024/2025 School Year.
- No single school will receive more than one grant per school year.
- Grant funds of up to \$500 will be awarded via a check made out directly to the school.
- Expedition Foundation Board members, Expedition Credit Union Board and Committee members, Expedition Credit Union staff, or any immediate family members of those noted above, are not eligible to apply.

Grant recipient agreement

Once applications are received they are considered property of the Foundation. The grant recipients agree to have their names, school names and description of their programs used in foundation newsletters and other publications.
