

2025 Scholarship Awards.

High School Student Application

Thank you for your interest in the Expedition Foundation's 2025 Scholarship Program.

Eligibility

The Student award is for graduating high school seniors. You must be a member of Expedition Credit Union, or the child, grandchild, or dependent of a member to be eligible for the award. You must be planning to attend a university, college, or community college in the fall of 2025. It is not necessary to demonstrate a financial need for the award.

Selection

Three recipients will be selected for a \$1,000 award by a Scholarship Committee to be named by the Foundation Board of Directors. Decisions of the Scholarship Committee are final and are not subject to review.

The applicants will be scored on the following areas:

- **Up to 6 points each: Participation Details & Essay Response** (located within application packet)
- **Up to 5 points for two letters of recommendation** from teachers, school counselors, supervisors, community leaders, etc. These items may be mailed separately to ensure confidentiality.
- **Up to 3 points for your official high school transcripts;** include the first term of senior year.

How to Apply?

Applications can be found at www.expeditioncu.com/scholarships. The deadline for submitting applications, including 2 letters of recommendation and your most recent transcripts, is by midnight on February 7, 2025.

Complete the Online PDF and email it to scholarships@expeditioncu.com. Or print off the completed PDF and drop it off at a branch or mail it to: Expedition Credit Union, Attn: Foundation Scholarship Committee, 1270 Northland Drive, Suite 350, Mendota Heights, MN 55120. Must be postmarked no later than February 7, 2025.

Application materials should be typed before being submitted. Handwritten applications will be disqualified.

Disclosure Policy

Once applications are received, they are considered property of the Foundation. All applications will be destroyed following the selection of the winner. In respect of our applicants' privacy, all applications, forms, and details will only be shared with the Scholarship Committee.

Scholarship Recipient Agreement

The scholarship recipients agree to submit a photo to the Foundation at the time of receiving the award and agree to have their full names and brief biographies used in Foundation and credit union newsletters and publications.

The awards will be given in the form of a check made out to the winner and the school they are attending. If, at the time of the award the school is unknown, Expedition Foundation will hold the funds until a school is selected.
